OUR FAITH

“Your light must shine before all so that they may see goodness in your acts”

(Matt 5:16)

Giving of our time, talent and treasure mainly involves a change of attitude about giving. It’s important to think in terms of giving in gratitude to God, of considering how blessed we are, of using our gifts and talents for the good of others. In the area of time, and talent, many individuals commit a certain number of hours each week to prayer and charitable activities. In the area of treasure, some Christians choose the biblical norm of giving 10 percent of their treasure. Some because of circumstances, give more than that. Others might start at 2, 3, or 4 percent, and work upwards.

Q How do our needs or the needs of a family fit into the concept of stewardship?

A Your first responsibility is to take care of your needs and the needs of your family—not necessarily all their wants. In looking very carefully at what we need versus what we want, we end up placing material things and money in their proper perspective. For example, when someone buys a new house, they may buy a somewhat smaller house than if they hadn’t been practicing stewardship of treasure. That smaller house can still meet their needs and may also meet many, but not all, of their wants. Stewardship of treasure asks only a percentage of income—not the whole thing. Many people find that when they trust in God and return a certain percentage of their income to the Church and other charities, they can live adequately on the rest of their income. That percentage is something that people decide in prayer and after due consideration of their needs and the needs of a family.

“Tu luz debe brillar delante de todos, para que vean el bien en tus acciones”

(Mt 5:16)

Dar nuestro tiempo, talento y tesoro implica principalmente un cambio de actitud acerca de dar. Es importante pensar en términos de dar en agradecimiento a Dios, de considerar cuán bendecidos somos, de usar nuestros dones y talentos para el bien de los demás. En el área del tiempo y el talento, muchas personas dedican un cierto número de horas cada semana a la oración y a actividades caritativas. En el área del los bienes, algunos cristianos eligen la norma bíblica de dar el 10 por ciento de sus bienes. Algunos, por las circunstancias, dan más que eso. Otros pueden comenzar con un 2, 3 o 4 por ciento y aumentar.

P ¿Cómo se relacionan nuestras necesidades familiares con la mayordomía?

R Tu primera responsabilidad es cuidar de tus necesidades y las necesidades de tu familia, no necesariamente todos sus deseos. Al examinar muy cuidadosamente lo que necesitamos versus lo que queremos, terminamos colocando las cosas materiales y el dinero en su perspectiva adecuada. Por ejemplo, cuando alguien compra una casa nueva, puede comprar una casa algo más pequeña que si no hubiera estado practicando la administración del tesoro. Esa casa más pequeña aún puede satisfacer sus necesidades y también muchas, pero no todas, sus aspiraciones. La administración del tesoro solo solicita un porcentaje del ingreso, no todo. Muchas personas descubren que cuando confían en Dios y devuelven un cierto porcentaje de sus ingresos a la Iglesia y otras organizaciones benéficas, pueden vivir adecuadamente con el resto de sus ingresos. Ese porcentaje es algo que las personas deciden en oración y después de una cuidadosa consideración de sus necesidades y las necesidades de su familia.
