OUR FAITH

Stewardship opens an avenue of thought that allows us to give without always questioning what we will get in return. Every one of us is talented in some way. Stewardship encourages us to use any talent we have to benefit an individual, the Church, or the community.

"What shall I return to the Lord for all the Lord has given to me?" (Ps 116:12)

Jesus asks us to demonstrate our love for him through our generosity to others. In our everyday lives, he calls us to share our gifts of time, talent, and treasure with others.

"While we have the opportunity, let us do good to all people-but especially to those of the household of the faith"

(Gal 6:10)

La mayordomía abre una vía de pensamiento que nos permite dar sin siempre cuestionar lo que recibiremos a cambio. Cada uno de nosotros tiene talento de alguna manera. La mayordomía nos anima a usar cualquier talento que tengamos para beneficiar a un individuo, a la Iglesia o a la comunidad.

"¿Qué le devolveré al Señor por todos los beneficios que me ha concedido?" (Salmo 116:12)

Jesús nos pide que demos nuestro amor por él a través de nuestra generosidad hacia los demás. En nuestra vida cotidiana, nos llama a compartir nuestros dones de tiempo, talento y tesoro con los demás.

"Mientras tengamos oportunidad, hagamos bien a todos, pero especialmente a los de la familia de la fe"

(Gal 6:10)

Q How important is it for our children to be taught about stewardship of time, talent, and treasure?

A It is very important, and the earlier we can begin teaching them, the better. We teach children while they are very young about Jesus, about prayer, and about love. We take them to church every week. These are all important parts of the Christian life.

Giving of ourselves is an important part of our Christian life, and we need to start teaching children the meaning of giving while they are young. More and more churches are encouraging children to return a percentage of their allowance or other income by putting a children's envelope into the collection basket. More and more parents, for example, are visiting shut-ins or people in nursing homes and taking a child along with them when they visit. More and more religious education programs or youth groups, for example, are organizing efforts for their children to mail cards to sick parishioners or make food baskets for the poor.

P ¿Qué tan importante es que se les enseñe a nuestros hijos acerca de la mayordomía del tiempo, el talento y el tesoro?

R Es muy importante, y cuanto antes podamos empezar a enseñarles, mejor. Enseñamos a los niños desde muy pequeños acerca de Jesús, la oración y el amor. Los llevamos a la iglesia todas las semanas. Todos estos son aspectos importantes de la vida cristiana.

Dar de nosotros mismos es una parte importante de nuestra vida cristiana, y necesitamos empezar a enseñar a los niños el significado de dar mientras son jóvenes. Cada vez más iglesias están animando a los niños a devolver un porcentaje de su asignación u otro ingreso colocando un sobre infantil en la canasta de la colecta. Cada vez más padres, por ejemplo, están visitando a personas mayores o a personas en hogares de ancianos y llevando a un niño con ellos cuando visitan. Cada vez más programas de educación religiosa o grupos juveniles, por ejemplo, están organizando esfuerzos para que sus niños envíen tarjetas a feligreses enfermos o hagan cestas de comida para los pobres.
