# STEWARDSHIP

*Managing God's Gifts To Us*

## Our Faith

Jesus asked us to commit ourselves to be good stewards of the gifts, and trusted to us, to share our time, our talent, and our treasure has an outward sign of the love and gratitude we have for him.

How much time have you spent this week and for the work of the church?

Have you ever thought about how many hours you doing things for yourself? How many you been doing things for others

"Let him with two coats, give to the one to him who has none" (Luke 3:11).

## Nuestra Fe

### Doesn't the Church talk about money too much?

Individual parishes may or may not talk about money too much but the reality is that God's work requires money. In fact, it is a duty of the Church to ask for money, not only for its work, but for the work that is done by charitable organization in the community. The Church sees so much suffering and so much needs to be addressed and has a responsibility to address that suffering and those needs.

Even Jesus' apostles had a treasurer who kept track of their expenses, and we read in the Bible of certain wealthy women who followed Jesus and his disciples, helping to support them out of their own means. The Apostle Paul also on a number of occasions urged churches to give money to help those in need.

The Church today is focusing itself much more on the stewardship that on "talking about money."

Stewardship is based on individual's needs to give, not on the Church's need to receive. Stewardship is based on the premise that all that we have and all that we are comes from God and, as a way to thank God for all his blessings, we return a portion of the time, talent, and treasure allotted to us.

### ¿No habla demasiado la Iglesia de dinero?

Las parroquias individuales pueden o no hablar demasiado sobre el dinero, pero la realidad es que la obra de Dios requiere dinero. De hecho, es un deber de la Iglesia pedir dinero, no sólo para su trabajo, sino para el trabajo que realiza la organización caritativa en la comunidad. La Iglesia ve tanto sufrimiento y tantas necesidades que abordar y tiene la responsabilidad de abordar ese sufrimiento y esas necesidades.

Incluso los apóstoles de Jesús tenían un tesorero que llevaba la cuenta de sus gastos, y leemos en la Biblia sobre ciertas mujeres ricas que siguieron a Jesús y sus discípulos, ayudándolos a sustentarse con sus propios medios. El apóstol Pablo también instó en varias ocasiones a las iglesias a donar dinero para ayudar a los necesitados.

La Iglesia hoy se está centrando mucho más en la mayordomía que en "hablar de dinero". La mayordomía se basa en las necesidades de dar del individuo, no en la necesidad de recibir de la Iglesia. La mayordomía se basa en la premisa de que todo lo que tenemos y todo lo que somos proviene de Dios y, como una manera de agradecer a Dios por todas sus bendiciones, devolvemos una porción del tiempo, talento y tesoro que se nos ha asignado.
