# STEWARDSHIP

*Managing God's Gifts To Us*

## Our Faith

Stewardship is a way of life, a way of thanking God for all the divine blessings we have received by returning a portion of the time, talent, and treasure allotted to us. Stewardship is based on the spiritual principles of the Old Testament and the teachings of Jesus. Word has been implemented, both givers' and receivers' lives have been changed. Stewardship and engenders a spirituality that deepens our relationship with Jesus. Stewardship involves intentional, planned, and proportionate, giving of our time, talent, and treasure. "Give, and shall be given to you. Good measure pressed down, shaken together, running over, will they pour into the fold of your garment. For the measure you measure with will be measured back to you" (Luke 6:38).

"Above all, let your love for one another be constant, for love covers a multitude of sins. Be mutually hospitable without complaining. As a generous distributors of God's manifold grace, put your gifts at the service of one another, and each in the measure you have received closed" (1Pet 4:8-10).

### **What about all the people in my parish who give nothing at all?**

The questions is not "What about them?" It is "What about me?" As we grow in our Christian faith, we learn to become more honest with ourselves before God. Rather than scrutinize those around us regarding their giving, we turn within ourselves and ask: "Is my giving enough?" Am I truly giving to God from my first fruits, or am I giving God what is left over after all of my needs are met?"

While it is natural for us to compare what we do to what other do, our Christian faith calls us to consider how our actions confirm to what God would have us do. In comparing ourselves to others, we are missing the mark because a Christians we are called to be different from other people. Living a life committed to stewardship is part of the different way of living.

Each of us can find in our own hearts the seeds of faults we spot so easily in others. Our giving should not be based on what others give. Giving rather, involves a personal decision we must make for ourselves, and then we offer our gifts to our parish and the community.

## Nuestra Fe

"Dad, y os será dado. Buena medida apretada, remecida, rebosante, se derramará en el pliegue de tu manto. Porque la medida con la que midáis, os será medida" (Lucas 6:38).

"Sobre todo, que vuestro amor mutuo sea constante, porque el amor cubre multitud de pecados. Sed mutuamente hospitalarios sin quejaros. Como generosos distribuidores de la multiforme gracia de Dios, poned vuestros dones al servicio de los demás, y cada uno en la medida que los haya recibido» (1Pe 4,8-10).

### **¿Y toda la gente de mi parroquia que no dan nada en absoluto?**

La pregunta no es "¿Qué pasa con ellos?" Es "¿Qué hay de mí?" A medida que crecemos en nuestra fe cristiana, aprendemos a ser más honestos con nosotros mismos ante Dios. En lugar de escudriñar a quienes nos rodean en cuanto a sus donaciones, nos volvemos hacia nosotros mismos y nos preguntamos: "¿Es suficiente mi donación?" ¿Estoy realmente dando a Dios desde mis primicias, o le estoy dando a Dios lo que sobra después de satisfacer todas mis necesidades?

Si bien es natural para nosotros comparar lo que hacemos con lo que otros hacen, nuestra fe cristiana nos llama a considerar cómo nuestras acciones confirman lo que Dios quiere que hagamos. Al compararnos con los demás, estamos errando el blanco porque como cristianos estamos llamados a ser diferentes de los demás. Vivir una vida comprometida con la corresponsabilidad es parte de una forma diferente de vivir.

Cada uno de nosotros puede encontrar en nuestro propio oído las semillas de los defectos que detectamos tan fácilmente en los demás. Nuestro dar no debe basarse en lo que otros dan. Más bien, dar implica una decisión personal que debemos tomar por nosotros mismos y luego ofrecemos nuestras ofrendas a nuestra parroquia y a la comunidad.
