Rather, we are declaring, "We are inviting you to invest yourself through the resources that God has given you - your energy, your prayers, and your money - in this work to which God has called us." Our invitation is clear and confident, because we trust that our vision and mission are like "trees planted by streams of water, which yield their fruit in its season, and their leaves do not wither" (Ps. 1:3).

On this day we pray for our priests and participate in the celebration of Mass, attend Eucharistic Adoration, and offer small sacrifices for the increase and sanctification of priests.

Globally, there is one priest for every 3,314 Catholics in the world. In the Americas, there is one priest for every 2,086 Catholics. In the Archdiocese of San Antonio, there is one priest for every 4,014 Catholics.

Please do not wait until a person is at the point of death to request the Anointing of the Sick.




