Managing God's Gifts To Us

Our Faith

Have you ever taken a moment to figure out how much time, on the average, you spend a week volunteering in your church or in your community?

"Do not neglect good deeds of generosity. God is pleased by sacrifices of that kind" (Heb 13:16).

Have you ever taken some time to figure out what percentage of your income goes to the church and other charitable causes? Stewardship is planned giving and is not giving to chance. It challenges us to plan. It asks us to appraise – deliberately – what we are doing with our time, our talents, and our treasure.

Fundraising as a Ministry

Fundraising is also a call to conversion. And this call comes to both those who seek funds and those who have funds. Whether we are asking for money or giving money, we are drawn together by God, who is about to do a new thing through our collaboration (Isa. 43:19). To be converted means to experience a deep shift and how we see and think an act. To be converted is to be clothed in our right mind, to come to ourselves the way the younger son did when he was starving from his home (Luke 15:14-20). It is a shift of attention in which we set our mind on divine things (Matt. 16:23). "Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your minds, so that you may discern what is the will of God – what is good and acceptable and closed" (Rom. 12:2). Fundraising as a ministry involves a real conversion.

The Meaning of Priestly Thursday

The Foundation of Priestly Thursday is based on Holy Thursday, when Jesus instituted the Holy Eucharist and the gift of Priesthood. This is why on Thursdays we make an offering of our lives, in union with Jesus, for the increase and sanctification of priests.

On this day we pray for our priests and participate in the celebration of Mass, attend Eucharistic Adoration, and offer small sacrifices for the increase and sanctification of priests.

Globally, there is one priest for every 3,314 Catholics in the world. In the Americas, there is one priest for every 2,086 Catholics. **In the Archdiocese of San Antonio, there is one priest for every 4,014 Catholics.**

Please do not wait until a person is at the point of death to request the Anointing of the Sick.

Convertirse es revestirse de nuestro sano juicio, volver en sí como lo hizo el hijo menor cuando salía hambriento de su casa (Lc. 15:14-20). Es un cambio de atención en el que ponemos nuestra mente en las cosas divinas (Mt. 16:23). "No os conforméis a este mundo, sino transformaos por medio de la renovación de vuestro entendimiento, para que podáis discernir cuál es la voluntad de Dios: lo que es bueno, aceptable y cerrado" (Rom. 12:2). 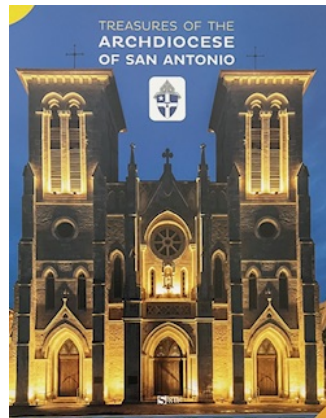
