## Our Faith

Christian Stewart provides a spirituality that you can take home from church, exercise at work, and express through personal involvement in the community and the church. Stewardship is not job-oriented or project-minded. It is a way of life for a lifetime. Christian stewardship takes a positive view on money. It sees not only as a medium of exchange, but as a symbol of the person who has it. The way we acquire it, use it, and share it; we are revealed in those actions. Christian Stewart trains us to become aware that God is the ultimate giver of the gifts we have. To give to God should be "from the top" – not what may be left over.

### Fundraising as a Ministry

And fundraising as a ministry, we are inviting people into a new way of relating to their resources. By giving people a spiritual vision, we want them to experience that they will, in fact benefit by making their resources available to us. We truly believe their gift is good only for us who receive, it is not fundraising in the spiritual sense. Fundraising From the point of view of the gospel says to people: "I will take your money and invested in this vision only if it is good for you your spiritual journey, only if it is good for your spiritual health. Closed "in other words, we are calling them to an experience of conversion: "you won't become poor, you will become richer by giving." We can confidently declare with the apostle Paul: "you will be enriched in every way for your generosity" (2 Cor. 9:11).

### The Meaning of Priestly Thursday

The Foundation of Priestly Thursday is based on Holy Thursday, when Jesus instituted the Holy Eucharist and the gift of Priesthood. This is why on Thursdays we make an offering of our lives, in union with Jesus, for the increase and sanctification of priests.

On this day we pray for our priests and participate in the celebration of Mass, attend Eucharistic Adoration, and offer small sacrifices for the increase and sanctification of priests.

Globally, there is one priest for every 3,314 Catholics in the world. In the Americas, there is one priest for every 2, 086 Catholics. **In the Archdiocese of San Antonio, there is one priest for every 4,014 Catholics.**

## Nuestra Fe

Al dar a la gente una visión espiritual, queremos que experimenten que, de hecho, se beneficiarán al poner sus recursos a nuestra disposición. Creemos de verdad que su donativo sólo nos beneficia a nosotros, los que lo recibimos; no se trata de recaudar fondos en el sentido espiritual. La recaudación de fondos desde el punto de vista del evangelio dice a la gente: «Voy a tomar su dinero e invertido en esta visión sólo si es bueno para usted su viaje espiritual, sólo si es bueno para su salud espiritual. Cerrado «en otras palabras, les estamos llamando a una experiencia de conversión: «no te harás pobre, te harás más rico dando». Podemos declarar con confianza con el apóstol Pablo: «os enriqueceréis en todo por vuestra generosidad» (2 Cor. 9:11).

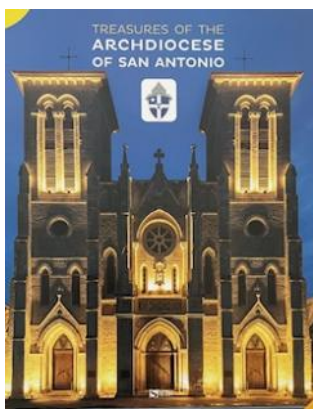

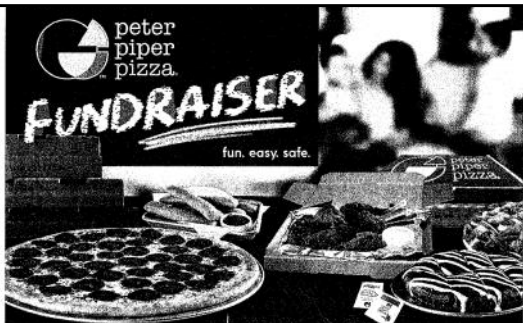
