Managing God's Gifts To Us

Our Faith

Christian Steward provides a spirituality that you can take home from church, exercise at work, and express through personal involvement in the community and the church. Stewardship is not job-oriented or project-minded. It is a way of life for a lifetime. Christian stewardship takes a positive view on money. It sees not only as a medium of exchange, but as a symbol of the person who has it. The way we acquire it, use it, and share it; we are revealed in those actions. Christian Steward trains us to become aware that God is the ultimate giver of the gifts we have. To give to God should be "from the top" – not what may be left over.

Fundraising as a Ministry

Here we see that if fundraising as ministry invites those with money to a new relationship with their wealth, it also calls us to be converted in relation to our needs. If we come back from asking someone for money and we feel exhausted and somehow tainted by unspiritual activity, there is something wrong. We must not let ourselves be tricked into thinking that fundraising is only a secular activity. As a form of ministry, fundraising is a spiritual as giving a sermon, entering a time of prayer, visiting the sick, or feeding the hungry. So fundraising has to help us with our conversion too. Are we willing to be converted from our fear of asking, our anxiety about being rejected or feeling humiliated, our depression when someone says, "No, I'm not going to get involved in your project"? When we have gained the freedom to ask without fear, to love fundraising as a form of ministry, then fundraising will be good for our spiritual life.

Nuestra Fe

La Solidaridad cristiana proporciona una espiritualidad que puedes llevar a casa desde la iglesia, ejercitar en el trabajo y expresar a través de la implicación personal en la comunidad y en la iglesia. La corresponsabilidad no está orientada al trabajo o a un proyecto. Es un estilo de vida para toda la vida. La solidaridad cristiana tiene una visión positiva del dinero. No lo ve sólo como un medio de intercambio, sino como un símbolo de la persona que lo posee. La forma en que lo adquirimos, lo usamos y lo compartimos; nos revelamos en esas acciones. La solidaridad cristiana nos entrena para tomar conciencia de que Dios es el dador último de los dones que tenemos. Dar a Dios debe ser «desde arriba», no lo que pueda sobrar.

Recaudación de fondos como ministerio

Aquí vemos que si la recaudación de fondos como ministerio invita a los que tienen dinero a una nueva relación con su riqueza, también nos llama a nosotros a convertirnos en relación con nuestras necesidades. Si volvemos de pedir dinero a alguien y nos sentimos agotados y de alguna manera manchados por una actividad poco espiritual, algo va mal. No debemos dejarnos engañar pensando que la recaudación de fondos es sólo una actividad secular. Como forma de ministerio, la recaudación de fondos es tan espiritual como dar un sermón, entrar en un tiempo de oración, visitar a los enfermos o alimentar a los hambrientos. Así que la recaudación de fondos también tiene que ayudarnos en nuestra conversión. ¿Estamos dispuestos a convertirnos de nuestro miedo a pedir, de nuestra ansiedad por ser rechazados o sentirnos humillados, de nuestra depresión cuando alguien nos dice: «No, no voy a participar en tu proyecto»? Cuando hayamos adquirido la libertad de pedir sin miedo, de amar la recaudación de fondos como una forma de ministerio, entonces la recaudación de fondos será buena para nuestra vida espiritual.

The Foundation of Priestly Thursday is based on Holy Thursday, when Jesus instituted the Holy Eucharist and the gift of Priesthood. This is why on Thursdays we make an offering of our lives, in union with Jesus, for the increase and sanctification of priests.

On this day we pray for our priests and participate in the celebration of Mass, attend Eucharistic Adoration, and offer small sacrifices for the increase and sanctification of priests.

Globally, there is one priest for every 3,314 Catholics in the world. In the Americas, there is one priest for every 2,086 Catholics. **In the Archdiocese of San Antonio, there is one priest for every 4,014 Catholics.**

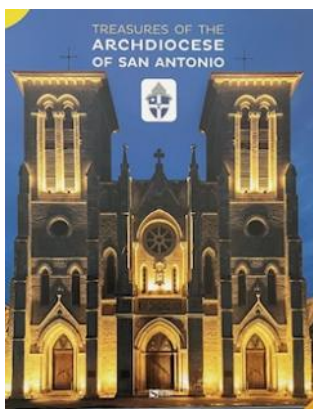

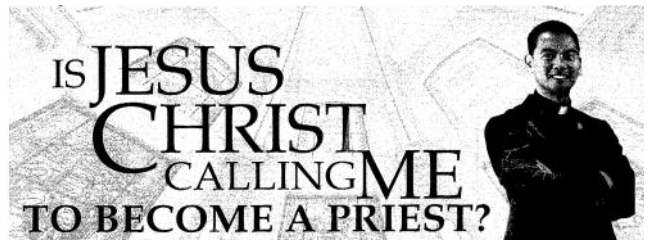
