The Foundation of Priestly Thursday is based on Holy Thursday, when Jesus instituted the Holy Eucharist and the gift of Priesthood. This is why on Thursdays we make an offering of our lives, in union with Jesus, for the increase and sanctification of priests.

On this day we pray for our priests and participate in the celebration of Mass, attend Eucharistic Adoration, and offer small sacrifices for the increase and sanctification of priests.

Globally, there is one priest for every 3,314 Catholics in the world. In the Americas, there is one priest for every 2,086 Catholics. In the Archdiocese of San Antonio, there is one priest for every 4,014 Catholics.

It is best not wait until a person is at the point of death to request the Anointing of the Sick.




