OUR FAITH

Stewardship opens an avenue of thought that allows us to give without always questioning what we will get in return. Every one of us is talented in some way. Stewardship encourages us to use any talent we have to benefit an individual, the Church, or the community.

"What shall I return to the Lord for all the Lord has given to me?" (Ps 116:12)

Jesus asks us to demonstrate our love for him through our generosity to others. In our everyday lives, he calls us to share our gifts of time, talent, and treasure with others.

"While we have the opportunity, let us do good to all people-but especially to those of the household of the faith"

(Gal 6:10)

Q If we are already committed to paying tuition because we have children in a Catholic school, does that tuition count as part of our commitment to stewardship of treasure?

A Each person ultimately decides for herself or himself what is to be counted as her or his stewardship of treasure. In looking at the true meaning of stewardship, however, tuition would not be included in stewardship of treasure because it is a payment made for services received: Catholic education. Stewardship is giving in gratitude to God with no expectation of receiving anything concrete, like an education, in return.

While tuition may not be included in stewardship of treasure, it can affect the percentage of income that some families can give to the Church and other charities.

Jesús nos pide que demostremos nuestro amor por él a través de nuestra generosidad hacia los demás. En nuestra vida cotidiana, nos llama a compartir nuestros dones de tiempo, talento y tesoro con los demás.

"Mientras tengamos oportunidad, hagamos bien a todos, pero especialmente a los de la familia de la fe"

(Gal 6:10)

P Si ya estamos comprometidos a pagar la matrícula porque tenemos hijos en una escuela católica, ¿cuenta esa matrícula como parte de nuestro compromiso con la mayordomía del tesoro?

R Cada persona en última instancia decide por sí misma lo que se contará como su mayordomía del tesoro. Sin embargo, al considerar el verdadero significado de la mayordomía, la matrícula no se incluiría en la mayordomía del tesoro porque es un pago por servicios recibidos: educación católica. La mayordomía implica dar en gratitud a Dios sin esperar recibir nada concreto a cambio, como una educación.

Aunque la matrícula puede no incluirse en la mayordomía del tesoro, puede afectar el porcentaje de ingresos que algunas familias pueden dar a la Iglesia y otras organizaciones benéficas.
