# OUR FAITH

**Q** How can we make our fellow parishoners and our families more regulary aware of stewardship?

**A** There are many ways to make others more regularly aware of stewardship. One simple way is through prayer. Following are two simple prayers that can be said at Mass (maybe once a month) and at home (maybe once a week):

## Stewardship Prayer

Lord God, you alone are the source of every good gift, of the vast array of our universe, and the mystery of each human life. We praise you and we thank you for your great power and your tender, faithful love. Everything we are and everything we have is your gift, and after having created us you have given us into the keeping of your Son, Jesus Christ. Fill our minds with his truth and our hearts with his love, that in his Spirit we may be bonded together into a community of faith, a parish family, a caring people. In the name and spirit of Jesus, we commit ourselves to be good stewards of the gifts entrusted to us, to share our time, our talent, and our material gifts as an outward sign of the treasure we hold in Jesus. Amen.

## Prayer for Generosity

Lord Jesus, you came to tell us that the meaning of life consists in giving. You told us that those who cling too tightly to what they have-without thought for you or others-end up losing everything. You gave us new values by which to measure the worth of a person's life. Help us to realize it is not temporal success or riches or fame that gives life meaning. Rather, it is the service rendered to you and others that brings fulfillment and makes our lives worthwhile.

May all our activity help build God's kingdom:

our obedience bring true freedom,  
our generosity increase love,  
our sacrifice bear generous fruit,  
our death lead to eternal life.

**P** ¿Cómo podemos hacer que nuestros compañeros feligreses y nuestras familias estén más regularmente conscientes de la mayordomía?

**R** Hay muchas maneras de hacer que otros estén más regularmente conscientes de la administración. Una manera simple es a través de la oración. A continuación, hay dos oraciones simples que se pueden decir en la Misa (quizás una vez al mes) y en casa (quizás una vez a la semana):

## Oración de Administración

Señor Dios, tú solo eres la fuente de todo buen regalo, del vasto conjunto de nuestro universo y del misterio de cada vida humana. Te alabamos y te damos gracias por tu gran poder y tu tierno y fiel amor. Todo lo que somos y todo lo que tenemos es tu regalo, y después de habernos creado, nos has confiado a tu Hijo, Jesucristo. Llena nuestras mentes con su verdad y nuestros corazones con su amor, para que en su Espíritu estemos unidos en una comunidad de fe, una familia parroquial, un pueblo solidario. En el nombre y en el espíritu de Jesús, nos comprometemos a ser buenos administradores de los dones confiados a nosotros, a compartir nuestro tiempo, nuestro talento y nuestros dones materiales como un signo externo del tesoro que tenemos en Jesús. Amén.

## Oración para la Generosidad

Señor Jesús, viniste a decirnos que el significado de la vida consiste en dar. Nos dijiste que aquellos que se aferran demasiado a lo que tienen, sin pensar en ti o en otros, terminan perdiéndolo todo. Nos diste nuevos valores con los cuales medir el valor de la vida de una persona. Ayúdanos a comprender que no es el éxito temporal, las riquezas o la fama lo que da sentido a la vida. Más bien, es el servicio prestado a ti y a otros lo que trae satisfacción y hace que nuestras vidas valgan la pena.
