# OUR FAITH

Stewardship opens an avenue of thought that allows us to give without always questioning what we will get in return. Every one of us is talented in some way. Stewardship encourages us to use any talent we have to benefit an individual, the Church, or the community.

*"What shall I return to the Lord for all the Lord has given to me?"* (Ps 116:12)

Jesus asks us to demonstrate our love for him through our generosity to others. In our everyday lives, he calls us to share our gifts of time, talent, and treasure with others.

*"While we have the opportunity, let us do good to all people—but especially to those of the household of the faith"*

(Gal 6:10)

## Q What portion of my time, talent, and treasure should I give?

**A** Giving of our time, talent, and treasure mainly involves a change of attitude about giving. It's important to think in terms of giving in gratitude to God, of considering how blessed you are, of using your gifts and talents for the good of others. Once you have this change of attitude, you will be able to more readily determine, through prayer and thought, the portion of your time, talent, and treasure that you will give.

In the area of time and talent, many individuals commit a certain number of hours each week to prayer and charitable activities. That prayer can be by yourself, with your family, or with others. Those charitable activities can include working in your parish, with various community agencies, or with an individual in need.

In the area of treasure, some Christians choose the biblical norm of giving 10 percent of their treasure. Some, because of circumstances, give more than that. Others might start at 2, 3, or 4 percent. When you are at peace about the size of your gift, when you do not find yourself making excuses for its size, when you know in your heart that you have been completely honest with God and yourself, then your gift is the proper size.

Jesús nos pide que demos nuestro amor por él a través de nuestra generosidad hacia los demás. En nuestra vida cotidiana, nos llama a compartir nuestros dones de tiempo, talento y tesoro con los demás.

*"Mientras tengamos oportunidad, hagamos bien a todos, pero especialmente a los de la familia de la fe"*

(Gal 6:10)

## P ¿Qué porción de mi tiempo, talento y tesoro debo dar?

**R** El dar de nuestro tiempo, talento y tesoro principalmente implica un cambio de actitud sobre el dar. Es importante pensar en términos de dar en gratitud a Dios, de considerar cuán bendecidos estás, de usar tus dones y talentos para el bien de los demás. Una vez que hayas tenido este cambio de actitud, podrás determinar más fácilmente, a través de la oración y el pensamiento, la porción de tu tiempo, talento y tesoro que darás.

En el área de tiempo y talento, muchos individuos dedican un cierto número de horas cada semana a la oración y actividades caritativas. Esa oración puede ser individual, en familia o con otras personas. Esas actividades caritativas pueden incluir trabajar en tu parroquia, con varias agencias comunitarias o con una persona necesitada.

En el área del tesoro, algunos cristianos eligen la norma bíblica de dar el 10 por ciento de su tesoro. Algunos, debido a circunstancias, dan más que eso. Otros podrían empezar con el 2, 3 o 4 por ciento. Cuando estás en paz con el tamaño de tu donación, cuando no te encuentras buscando excusas por su tamaño, cuando sabes en tu corazón que has sido completamente honesto con Dios y contigo mismo, entonces tu donación es del tamaño adecuado.

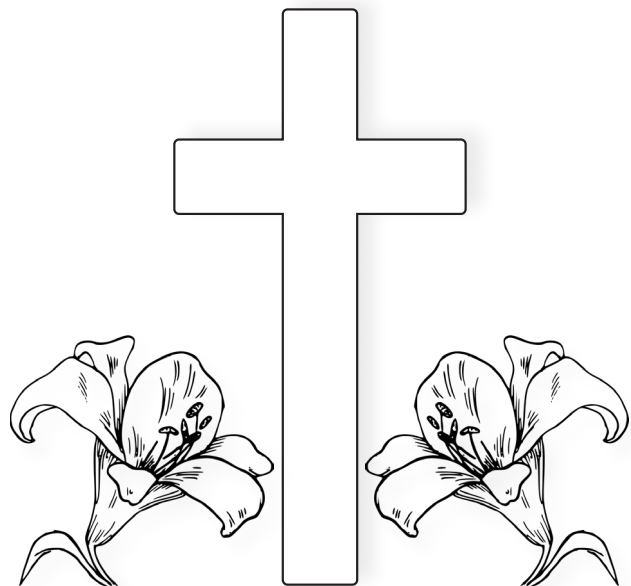
