

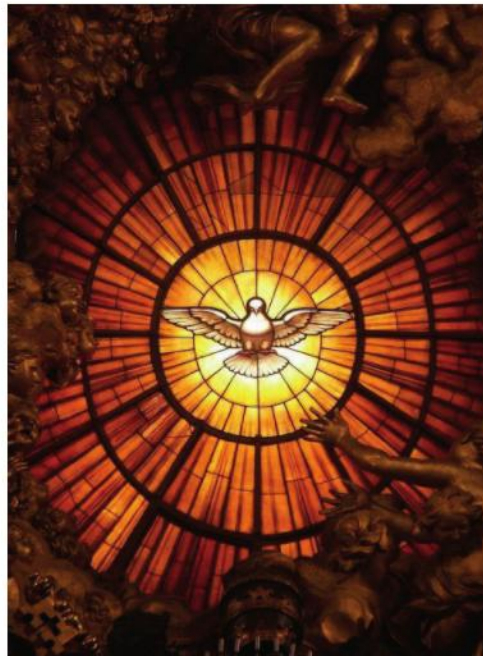

Spirituality of the Readings
Sixth Sunday of Easter (A)
May 14, 2023

Remembering the Truth
We live in an age when nostalgia sells. We have radio stations devoted to "oldies," that is, the music of some former era.

Television has an endless recall of shows from Jack Benny to Leave it to Beaver to I Love Lucy to ... you name it. Such a human thing it is to remember the spirit of the past and to understand better what we have done and have been. Can all of its media hype, be designed to "sell product"? We are tempted to say, yes, hype, hype, and nothing but hype. Yet much of what our nostalgia dredges up was good in its day and remains so.

Throughout Easter, the Church is recalling the adventures of the Church in the weeks after Jesus died and then rose again. We sit around the campfire of our memories, telling stories about how it was then. Philip. Remember Philip who told Jesus, "just show us the Father and that will be enough for us." Of course, he was seeing Jesus and therefore was looking at the Father, but he did not know it. And do you remember what Jesus said just before his passion and death? That he would send the Spirit of Truth into our hearts. And that we would not be left, orphans. It was hard to understand then and it is still pretty difficult.

Let us go over it one more time. Jesus seemed to say, first, that God the Abba was so much within Jesus that every time you see him it is the same thing as seeing God. Second, Jesus said, I am going to be so much within you—yes, you normal people—that whenever people see you it will be the same thing as seeing me! And of course, the Father is in me, so they see the Father too!

"I almost have it," Philip gulped.
So Jesus said it again. You will not see me anymore. But that doesn't make me absent from you. I and Abba will be within you so that your very spirit will hold the Spirit of me and of the Father. All you need to do is to say "yes." Then Philip saw it. In the upper room, he touched the truth. Very soon he was running from place to place doing miracles and preaching about the Messiah! With one accord, the crowds paid attention to what was said by Philip when they heard it and saw the signs he was doing. For unclean spirits, crying out in a loud

voice, came out of many possessed people, and many paralyzed or crippled people were cured. There was great joy in that city (First Reading)
We touch the truth and receive it also. Maybe it is not as dramatic as Philip's experience, but we have it every Sunday and any other day we choose to participate in Mass. We touch and receive Jesus on the tongue. Simple? No.

Well, maybe it is simple. This Sunday let us remember again not hype but these deepest, dearest mysteries of our lives.

La Espiritualidad de las Lecturas
Sexto Domingo de Pascua
14 de mayo, 2023

Recordar la Verdad
Nos fascina la nostalgia. Las emisoras emiten a todo volumen los viejos éxitos, la televisión repite sin cesar los programas de Jack Benny, "Leave it to Beaver," "I Love Lucy," "M*A*S*H," y un sinnúmero de otros. Es algo muy propio de los seres humanos recordar el espíritu del pasado. En parte, lo hacemos para mejor entender cómo hemos llegado a ser quienes somos. No todo es propaganda mediática, destinada a vender productos, aunque hay de eso también. Propaganda, propaganda, propaganda. Aun así, muchos de los frutos de nuestra nostalgia son buenos, y siguen siendo de valor. Impulsados por Dios, recordamos lo que significa ser Cristiano. Especialmente durante el tiempo de Pascua, nos sentamos alrededor de la fogata de nuestros recuerdos y contamos cuentos. Piensa en Felipe, que le dijo a Jesús, "Señor, muéstranos al Padre y nos basta." Desde luego, Felipe en ese momento veía a Jesús, y por lo tanto al Padre, pero lo ignoraba. Alguien se acerca un poco más a la fogata y dice, "¿Se acuerdan de las palabras que Jesús pronunció justo antes de su pasión y muerte? Que enviaría el Espíritu de la Verdad a nuestros corazones. Y que no nos dejaría desamparados. Era muy difícil entenderlo entonces, y todavía nos cuesta bastante."

Alguien balbucea, "R-R-Repasémoslo una vez más." Un valiente intenta resumirlo. "Primero, Jesús decía, "Dios, el Abba, está dentro de mí, de modo que cada vez que me ven a mí, ven a Dios." Segundo, dijo, "Voy a tener esa misma relación con ustedes. Estaré tan profundamente dentro de ustedes--sí, la gente común--que cuando alguien los vea, será como verme a mí."

"Y, por supuesto, ya que el Padre habita en mí, ellos conocerán también al Padre."
Felipe tragó saliva. "Casi entiendo. Tal vez. O a lo mejor no. Inténtalo otra vez, por favor."

"Bien," dice Jesús. "Voy a regresar al Padre, al que me envió. El mundo ya no me verá. Pero eso no significa que me aleje de ustedes. El Abba y yo habitaremos en ustedes en lo más profundo de su ser. Ustedes se unirán

al Espíritu que comparto con el Padre. Dicho en otras palabras:

“El que me vea a mí ve al Padre.”

“El que los vea a ustedes me ve a mí.”

Felipe por fin vio la luz del día. Vio la verdad. Míralo en la Primera Lectura. Abandona la fogata de los recuerdos y empieza a correr por todas partes haciendo milagros y predicando sobre el Mesías. El genfío escuchaba con aprobación lo que decía Felipe, porque habían oído hablar de los signos que hacía y los estaban viendo: de muchos poseídos salían los espíritus inmundos lanzando gritos, y muchos paralíticos y lisiados se curaban. La ciudad se llenó de alegría.

¿Tú también logras ver la luz del día, por lo menos algunas veces? ¿Respondes con un “sí” a la presencia de Cristo en ti? ¿Tocas y recibes sobre tu lengua a Jesús en la Misa hoy? ¿Te dejas unir a Cristo hoy? ¿Dices que “sí,” o muchas veces que “no”?

Si es que respondes negativamente, vuelve a leer las Lecturas para este domingo.

¿Fácil? No.

Pues, tal vez sea fácil. Sólo tienes que recibir y amar.

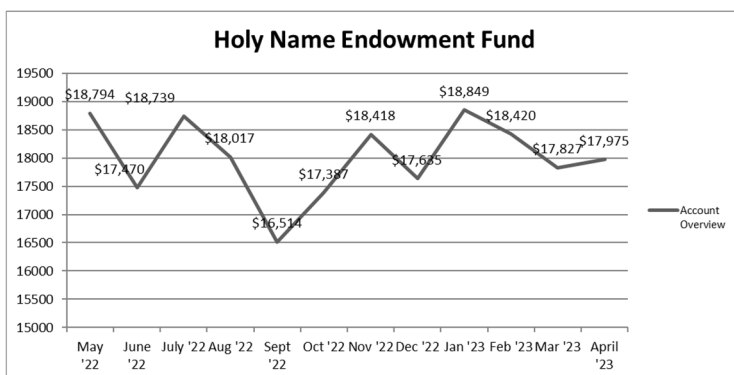
Purpose of the Fund:

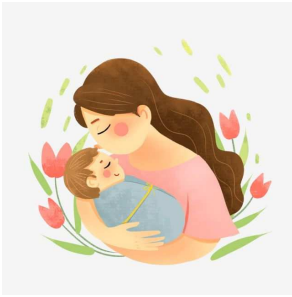
