## Spirituality of the Readings Pentecost Sunday (A) May 28, 2023

The Great Sharing  
Pentecost is a feast equal to Christmas and Easter in importance. It is the official sending of the Holy Spirit into men and women. We have been hearing Jesus talk about this

moment in the Gospels for weeks now. We have been hearing that he will not leave us alone, but will send the Spirit, the Paraclete, to us.

Now it has happened.

- The Father is so much within Jesus that if you know Jesus you know the Father.

- Just as the Father is within Jesus, Jesus will be within us.

- This will happen through the sending of the Holy Spirit, who is the “insides” of Jesus and of the Father. The Spirit is the love they have for each other, the closeness, the great sharing.

The first sign is that the apostles begin speaking in tongues. People from all different lands and languages gather and each understands the disciples’ words without any translation ([First Reading](#)). No small thing.

The reading then tells who the people in the crowd were:

- Parthians, Medes, and Elamites,
- inhabitants of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia,
- of Pontus and Asia, Phrygia and Pamphylia.
- Egypt and the districts of Libya near Cyrene;
- travelers from Rome, both Jews and converts to Judaism;
- Cretans and Arabs.

Language students of today wish they could talk in so many languages, don’t they? But the real point is deeper than that. God’s Holy Spirit means to bring us together, to allay differences, to let us hear other persons in the way they express themselves, not just to think about our own self. Each one has a “language” that expresses who they are (not a literal language, but an idiomatic way of speaking and acting that comes from the inside of who that person is). If you are able to hear, you can “listen through” characteristics and receive loving knowledge of that person, even if they have no intention of letting us in. But that is so difficult, you say. Some people you run into are just plain annoying. “So-and-so just talks on and on and I think I will go crazy if there is a minute more.” How in the world can we “hear” another human being?

With the aid of the Holy Spirit.

It is not magic. The work of the Spirit is to listen for the “insides” of the other person, as we saw above. If you

take Jesus seriously in the Gospel, you will hear with the aid of the Spirit, the Paraclete, which is Love given to the deepest part of you. Not Love instead of your freedom, but Love as a help, a push (not a shove) toward caring for everything in God, of course, and what is best in other people, even troublesome ones.

It takes time to learn all this, of course, to clear the various blockages inside us that keep the Spirit at bay. Remember, we are being invited into the greatest closeness possible, the great sharing that is God himself. Yes, it does take time. And we make a lot of mistakes. But God is willing to make us “temples of the Holy Spirit,” and to stay with us, strengthening us, guiding us, helping us to make Love a root in us.

## La Espiritualidad de las Lecturas Domingo De Pentecostés 28 de mayo, 2023

El Gran Compartir

El Pentecostés no es sólo un domingo más. Es una fiesta equivalente a la Navidad y la Pascua Florida. Supone el envío oficial del Espíritu Santo a las mujeres y a los hombres. Llevamos ya varias semanas escuchando a Jesús hablar de este momento en los Evangelios. Hemos oído que él no nos dejará abandonados, que nos enviará el Espíritu, el Paraclete. Aquí tienes un resumen:

- El Padre habita en Jesús hasta tal punto que conocer a Jesús es conocer también al Padre.
- Jesús se ofrece para habitar en nosotros de la misma manera.

. Esto sucederá por medio del envío del Espíritu Santo, quien es la esencia más profunda de Jesús y del Padre. El Espíritu es el amor que ellos tienen el uno por el otro, su cercanía, el gran compartir entre ellos.

Este domingo celebramos la realización de esta promesa. La primera señal es que los apóstoles comienzan a hablar en lenguas extranjeras. Se reúnen personas de todas las naciones de la tierra, y cada uno entiende las palabras de los discípulos sin necesidad de traducir. (Primera Lectura) Esto no es un hecho insignificante. La Lectura enumera los idiomas de la gente que estaba allí: Partos, medos, elamitas, habitantes de Mesopotamia, Judea y Capadocia, el Ponto y Asia, Frigia y Panfilia, Egipto y la zona de Libia que limita con Cirene, así como forasteros de Roma, judíos y prosélitos, cretenses y árabes.

Algunos de nosotros nacemos con el don de lenguas, pero no tantos y no de esta forma.

Pero el verdadero significado de este suceso va más allá. El Espíritu Santo de Dios procura unirnos a un nivel



más profundo. Salvar las distancias entre nosotros, permitirnos a oír a la otra persona sin estar pensando sólo en nosotros mismos. Cada persona tiene una "lengua" que expresa quién es (esta vez, no es una lengua en el sentido literal, sino una manera particular de hablar y de actuar que procede de lo más profundo del ser de esa persona) Si eres capaz de escuchar, puedes distinguir estas características y así adquirir un conocimiento afectuoso de la persona, aun si la persona no es consciente de haberte incluido. Pero, dices, eso es tan difícil. Algunas personas son simplemente insufribles. "Esa persona no hace otra cosa que hablar y creo que voy a volverme loco si tengo que soportarla un minuto más." Ya sabes cómo es eso. Así que, ¿cómo es posible para nosotros "oír" a otra persona?

Con la ayuda del Espíritu Santo.

Una de las obras del Espíritu Santo es escuchar para oír lo más profundo de la otra persona. Si tomas en serio a Jesús en el Evangelio, empezarás a pensar en el Espíritu Santo como el Amor, enviado a lo más profundo de tu ser. Este no es Amor a cambio de tu libertad, sino el Amor como una ayuda, un empujecito (y no un empujón) hacia el conocimiento de todo lo mejor en las otras personas, incluyendo a los insufribles, y, desde luego, en Dios. Nos toma tiempo aprender esto, por supuesto, a eliminar los varios obstáculos dentro de nosotros, los que nos impiden recibir el Espíritu. Recuerda, estamos invitados a participar en la más profunda cercanía posible, el gran compartir que es Dios mismo. Naturalmente, nos va a tomar tiempo. Pero Dios está dispuesto a hacernos "Templos de Espíritu Santo," y a habitar en nosotros, fortaleciéndonos, guiándonos, ayudándonos a hacer del Amor una parte de nuestro ser.


