**Spirituality of the Readings**  
**Fourth Sunday of Advent (A)**  
**December 18, 2022**

An Inner Assurance  
 A dream changed Joseph's life and ours. A mere dream, like what you and I have at night.  
 How trustworthy could this be? And yet the safety of Mary and the child Jesus depended on it. In his dream (*Gospel*), an angel told him that Mary's pregnancy was from the Holy

Spirit of God. Mary had accepted readily but without really understanding. This angel of the Lord told him in the dream that he should not be afraid of the pregnancy, even though he was not yet married to this woman.

Not be afraid? Already everyone could see that Joseph's fiancé was "in a family way." USA culture might applaud this fact, as it does when movie stars have children with whomever they please whenever they please. In Biblical culture, marriage was a sacred act [and not too long ago in our own], a participation in God's fidelity. It seemed that Mary had broken with that fidelity, at least as far as the townspeople could see. The Blessed Mother is a public sinner! No wonder Joseph was making arrangements for a "quiet divorce."

So why in the world would he trust a dream? A friend of mine said he dreamed one night about a kangaroo sitting on his roof in a rocking chair, smoking a pipe! Should my friend keep a rocking chair on the roof from now on, just in case? No. We take dreams for what they probably are, a mechanism of our psyche that somehow helps us but does not give us literal truth. We do not trust dreams for life-changing messages. Why did Joseph?

I think the answer has to do with something St. Ignatius of Loyola calls "discernment." In general, discernment is an examination of one's internal reactions to God ("movements") in prayer. There are many different kinds of interior movements to discern, but Ignatius notes a rare one first. There can be a time when grace is so quietly strong that the person praying has an inner assurance that the experience did not come from imagination but from God. In this case, no doubts are possible. You and I have to be careful not to get carried away by this notion. Probably many of us could convince ourselves that God or an angel spoke to us this morning. We need to discern which experiences are from God and which are not. Are they quiet? Do they lead toward God or away? What is the long-term result? A spiritual director could help us sort through such questions. Joseph's dream must have been a movement of this kind. It contained a quiet certainty of the presence of God. No doubts followed it, in a situation when doubts would surely seem called for. It was like the face of a mother to an infant. Like the voice of a close friend.

Another way to put it is that Joseph already had much trust in God's love. This trust was in no way broken into, shattered, or pulled to pieces by the dream. Instead, the message fit right into the design of Joseph's life with God. And so he followed it. What is your internal sense of the Christmas story? Is the birth of God an impossible tale reserved for children? Or do you find the roots of trust within yourself as Joseph did? Pray for the open faith Joseph and Mary had.

Soñar

Un sueño cambió la vida de José--y la nuestra también (Evangelio) Un simple sueño, como los que soñamos tú y yo todas las noches. ¿Cómo se podría confiar en un sueño? Sin embargo, la seguridad de María y el niño Jesús, y la del mundo entero, dependía de ello. En ese sueño, un ángel le dijo a José que la criatura que había en María venía del Espíritu Santo de Dios. María ya había aceptado esto de buena gana, pero sin acabar de comprenderlo. Y el ángel le dijo a José que no temiera recibir a su esposa, aunque no se había casado todavía con ella.

¿No temer? Todo el mundo podía ver que la desposada de José estaba "encinta." Es posible que en la cultura estadounidense este hecho sea aceptado, hasta aplaudido. Así como cuando las estrellas de cine tienen hijos con quienesquiera que quieran, cuando quieran. En la cultura bíblica, el matrimonio era sagrado, una forma de participar en la propia fidelidad de Dios, y parecía que María había incumplido con esa fidelidad, por lo menos desde la perspectiva de la gente del pueblo. ¡La Madre Santísima una pecadora común y corriente! No es de sorprenderse, entonces, que José ya había decidido "repudiarla en secreto."

¿Por qué José cambiaría de opinión, confiando en un sueño? ¿Tú confías en los sueños? ¡Un amigo mío soñó alguna vez que había un canguro sobre el techo, sentado en una silla mecedora fumando una pipa! ¿Le recomiendo a mi amigo que suba al techo a ver si hay una silla mecedora, por si acaso? No. Nosotros entendemos un sueño por lo que es: un mecanismo psíquico que procesa nuestras experiencias pero que no nos proporciona una verdad textual. No solemos confiar en ellos para información que nos vaya a cambiar la vida. ¿Por qué José lo hizo? Creo que la respuesta tiene algo que ver con lo que San Ignacio de Loyola llama "el discernimiento."

En términos generales, el discernimiento es un examen de las reacciones internas de la persona ("movimientos del espíritu"), especialmente las que suceden durante la oración. Hay muchos tipos de movimientos, desde luego, pero uno de ellos nos puede servir para entender el sueño de José. A veces, muy de vez en cuando, la gracia es tan suavemente fuerte que la persona que reza siente dentro de sí la certeza de que la experiencia procede, no de su imaginación, sino de Dios. De alguna manera, es imposible dudar de ella.

Tú y yo debemos tener mucho cuidado de no dejarnos llevar por esta idea. Probablemente muchos de nosotros podríamos convencernos de que Dios o un ángel nos habló esta mañana. Necesitamos "discernir" la diferencia entre las experiencias que vienen de Dios y las que no. ¿Son tranquilas? ¿Nos llevan hacia Dios o lejos de él? ¿Cuáles son sus consecuencias a largo plazo? Un director espiritual podría ayudarnos a contestar estas preguntas.

Pero yo creo que el sueño de José venía de Dios. Traía--no un canguro--sino la tranquila certeza de la presencia de Dios. No conllevaba dudas, aunque eso habría sido comprensible. El sueño de José era para él lo que es la cara de su madre para una criatura, lo que es la voz de un amigo íntimo.

José era bueno. Ya tenía todo un caudal de fé en el amor de Dios. No sintió que su sueño le hubiera robado su fe, ni que la hubiera destrozado. Al contrario, el mensaje del ángel encajaba perfectamente con el diseño de su vida con Dios y de su amor por María. Así que ellos obedecieron. ¿Cuál es tu manera de entender la historia de la Navidad? ¿Es imposible el nacimiento de Dios, algo reservado para los niños? ¿O tú encuentras las raíces de la fe dentro de ti, así como lo hizo José?


