# STEWARDSHIP

*Managing God's Gifts To Us*

## Our Faith

"Your light must shine before all so that they may see goodness in your acts" (Matt 5:16).

Giving of our time, talent and treasure mainly involves a change of attitude about giving. It's important to think in terms of giving in gratitude to God, of considering how blessed we are, of using our gifts and talents for the good of others.

In the area of time, and talent, many individuals commit a certain number of hours each week to prayer and charitable activities.

In the area of treasure, some Christians choose the biblical norm of giving 10 percent of their treasure. Some because of circumstances, give more than that. Others might start at 2, 3, or 4 percent, and work upwards.

### **What do you mean by stewardship of time and talent, and how important is it?**

Giving of time involves being with God in prayer and worship, sharing our love with family and friends, and volunteering our time in Church, and community activities that help others and promote justice. Sharing our talents arise from the fact that God has given each of us the ability and gifts to do certain things well and we are to develop those talents for the good of others.

Just as in stewardship of treasure, it is important that the giving of time, and talent be intentional, planned and proportionate. Many individuals commit a certain number of hours each week to prayer and charitable activities.

Giving of our time and talent is just as important as giving of our treasure. God does not hold back on any area of divine giving, so we are not to hold back on any area of our giving.

## Nuestra Fe

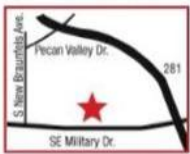
