## Our Faith

### Fundraising as a Ministry

Even a seemingly small act of generosity can grow into something far beyond what we could ever ask or imagine. (see Eph. 3:20) - the creation of a community of love in this world, and beyond this world, because wherever love grows, is stronger than death (1 Cor. 13:8). So when you give ourselves to planting and nurturing love here on earth, our efforts will reach out beyond our own chronological existence. Indeed, if we raise funds for the creation of a community of love, we are helping God build the kingdom. We are doing exactly what we are supposed to do as Christians. Paul is clear about this: "Make love your aim" (1 Cor. 14:1, NJB).

## Nuestra Fe

Estamos haciendo exactamente lo que se supone que debemos hacer como cristianos. Pablo es claro al respecto: «Haced del amor vuestro objetivo» (1 Cor. 14:1, NJB).

### *The Meaning of Priestly Thursday*

The Foundation of Priestly Thursday is based on Holy Thursday, when Jesus instituted the Holy Eucharist and the gift of Priesthood. This is why on Thursdays we make an offering of our lives, in union with Jesus, for the increase and sanctification of priests.

On this day we pray for our priests and participate in the celebration of Mass, attend Eucharistic Adoration, and offer small sacrifices for the increase and sanctification of priests.

Globally, there is one priest for every 3,314 Catholics in the world. In the Americas, there is one priest for every 2,086 Catholics. **In the Archdiocese of San Antonio, there is one priest for every 4,014 Catholics.**

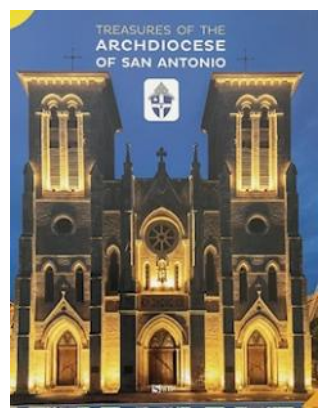

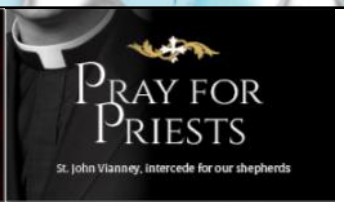

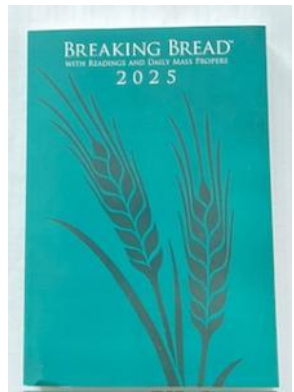
